**WE NEED YOUR HELP**

A few years ago, the cats in the shelter appeared to be threatened by someone or something that was tampering with the screened doors that are open all day long except during the cold winter months. We became very concerned for their safety, so we decided to install a chain-link fence that surrounds the shelter area. Unfortunately, our funds were very limited and we were only able to fence in a portion of the area.

This past spring we noticed more holes being torn in the screens on the garage doors that we keep open during the day so that the cats have plenty of fresh air. Because we are very concerned for the safety of our cats, we would like to finish the fence around the shelter.

This is where we need your help. We need approximately \$2,700 to complete the last phase of the fencing, so that the cats are totally protected. We know that money is tight for everyone, but if you can help, we would really appreciate any contribution.

We also recently learned that our washer is on its last leg. We do approximately eight to ten loads of towels and linens daily. The repairman said we have maybe six to eight weeks before our washer will die. A new washer that will last at least 10 years will cost about \$1,200.
